- Account for **Different** representations + processes
- **Sets** of measures
- Imply a large variety of sciences (and objects)
- physics (acoustics)
- Architects & other partners involved (ecology oriented) ...
- Physiology, psychophysics, psychology (mental representations)

Soundscapes as mental representations

- ✓ As a subjective (psychological) representation :
- √ individual and non-observable (but as concepts in physics)
- ✓ It is global and multimodal auditory, visual, kinaesthetic...,
- ✓ Always experienced in **context** and in practices; **not** unique
- ✓ "made of" **memory** includes perceptions **and responses** (actions) given to "inputs" in use
- ✓ both individual (sensory experience) and **collective** (GROUPS)
- ✓ It involves **interpretations** (**meaning** production vs "pre-existing or given "information processing")
- ✓ It is connected to, constructed by **linguistic** expressions
- ✓ therefore is shared and accessible through verbal and symbolic public observable representations
- ✓ Can be negotiated

Q3: What Tools are needed?

Range of investigations

- No single recipe
- Several layers (inheritage/ uses/ purposes)
- Plurality of point of views
 - Ex : Park (place) /recreational area (use)
- Level of segmentation
 - => list of requirements

List of requirements (criteria) (help to get at classes)

- List of Purposes
- History
- People there? Who are they? for what use? What activity?
 - Green sounds? Recreational areas?
 - For old and/or old persons?
 - How to live together ?

Marketing

- Goals: show evidence and benefits
 - Quality of life (functional Health, security)
 - Sustainability /ecology /economy
- Take account of the others
 - People
 - Scientists
 - Architects, urban planners ?
 - Politicians?

Who knows? Who design? Who decide?

- Dissemination of Awareness
 - to other actors
 - to students (for ex: to go to school of architecture...)
